

VILLAGE OF GLENWOOD

BY LAW NO. 104

A By-Law of the Village of Glenwood in the Province of Alberta to provide for the establishment of a Municipal Library.

WHEREAS the council of the Village of Glenwood deems it expedient to propose the establishment of a municipal library.

NOW THEREFORE, with the authority and under the provisions of Part III of 'The Libraries Act' and Amendments thereto, being Chapter 206 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970, the Council of the Village of duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- (1) There shall be established a municipal library for the Village of Glenwood.**
- (2) The Municipal Library shall be managed, regulated and controlled by a Library Board.**
- (3) The policies of the Municipal Library Board shall be governed by Parts III and VII of 'The Libraries Act' and Amendments and Regulations pertaining thereto.**
- (4) This By-Law shall take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.**

READ a first and second time and by unanimous consent of all councilors present a third time and finally passed this 14th day of May, A.D. 1980 at Glenwood, Alberta.
