

VILLAGE OF GLENWOOD

BY LAW NO. 101

A BYLAW of the Village of Glenwood, for the purpose of closing a portion of a public highway in accordance with Sections 175 and 177 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter 246, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1970.

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel and WHEREAS, application has been made to the Council to have the highway closed, and, WHEREAS, notice of intention of the Council to pass a by-law has been mailed by registered mail to persons registered or assessed as owners of the land abutting upon the portion of the highway so proposed to be closed at least two weeks before the date fixed for the passing of the by-law and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of the Council to pass a by-law has been published in the Glenwood Gleanings on January 23, 1980, and January 30, 1980, the last of such publications being at least two weeks before the day fixed for the passing of the by-law and WHEREAS, Council was petitioned by the following persons stating that they would be prejudicially affected by the by-law:

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council of the Village of Glenwood does hereby close the following described highway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations:

“The easterly 387 feet of Second Street North which lies between First Avenue West and Second Avenue West, as shown on Plan 1222AY.

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.”

READ a first and second reading, February 13, 1980, and a 3rd and final reading and passed this 24th day of June, A.D. 1980.
