



Dog licences are due in January of each year. Please renew your licence for your dog for 2026 and every year thereafter. Bylaw 219-2023 requires you to licence your dog.

Licencing is inexpensive in the Village of Glenwood - \$10 for a spayed or neutered dog and \$40 for an intact dog.

Licencing helps the Village ensure your lost dog will be returned to its rightful owner if impounded by Animal Control.

Bylaw 219-2023 Section 32 states:

Any person violating any provisions of this bylaw or any other person responsible for such violations shall be liable to a penalty of:

- a) Warning – First offence
- b) \$100.00 – Second offence
- c) \$250.00 – Third offence
- d) \$500.00 – Fourth and subsequent offences

Bylaw 219-2023 Section 33 states:

Any person violating any provisions of this bylaw where the dog has been deemed Aggressive in nature or any other persons responsible for such violations shall be liable to a penalty of:

- a) \$150.00 – First offence
- b) \$300.00 – Second offence
- c) \$500.00 – Third and subsequent offences

Licencing your dog helps keep your dog and the community safe.
