

A By-Law of the VILLAGE of GLENWOOD in the Province of ALBERTA to authorize the establishment of a **FIVE-MEMBER COUNCIL.**

Under authority and pursuant to the provisions of SECTION 27 (Parts 1 & 3) of the MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT -Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980 -Chapter M-26 with amendments as of September 18, 1986, the Village of Glenwood Council enacts as follows:
