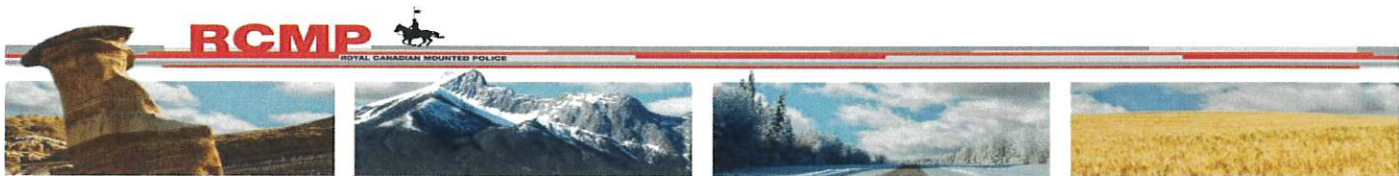
Dear Mayor, Reeve and Council,

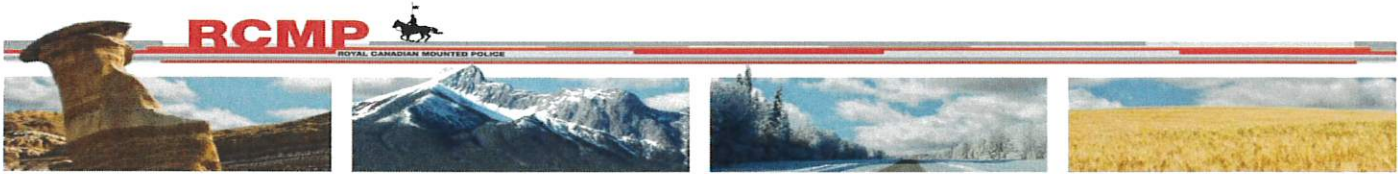

### Priority No. 1

Traffic Safety - Impaired driving & Enforcement of the TSA

Current Status and Results (this field expands)

Impaired driving target on the year was less than expected (19 / 30), some of this can be attributed to the current shortages in staffing and some to a training cycle that is still going on where ASD training is still needed for at least one RM. Coaldale Traffic have also conducted IRS / Impaired files in the area however they are not reflected in this report. Traffic enforcement succeeded the target on the year (372 / 300) and will be a continued initiative for next year.
