NOMINATION DAY - SEPTEMBER 20, 2021

Candidates were able to submit nomination papers as early as January 1, 2021 but must have them in by the September 20 deadline, referred to as nomination day, by 4:00 PM, in order to run in the municipal election in October.

Ordering Green Sleeves

The **Green sleeve** is a plastic pocket that holds important Advance Care Planning documents and other forms that outline a patient's goals for health care. It is for patients (anyone over 18 years of age) cared for in AHS (Alberta Health Services) who have had discussions, or completed documents, that refer to decision-making about their current or future health care. It sits on top of one's fridge in your home (where emergency services people would check for such information) for any guidance in case of an emergency in the home.

If you are ordering Green Sleeves for yourself or your family, you do not have to create an account. There is no cost to ordering and receiving a Green Sleeve.

Go here: <u>https://dol.datacm.com/</u>... Please enter "Greensleeves" as both the Username and the Password ("G" must be capitalized) and then click on the "Login" button. If you try to create your own account it will give you an error message. <u>No need for an account to order Greensleeves.</u>


