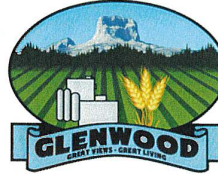

They are available 24/7.

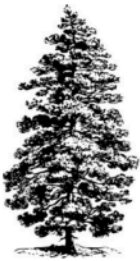

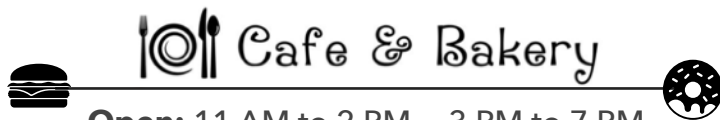

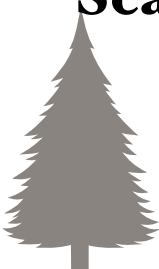
