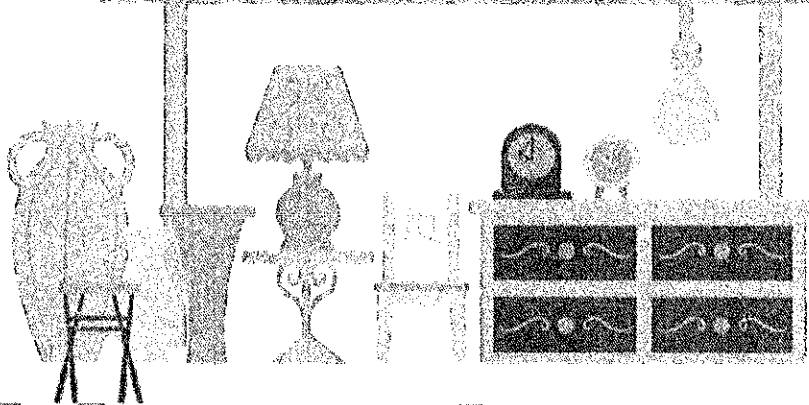

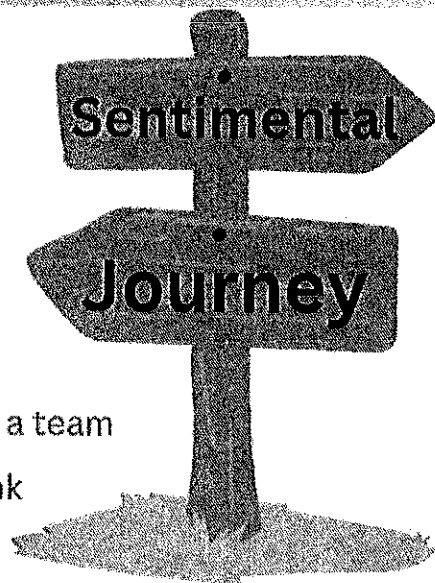

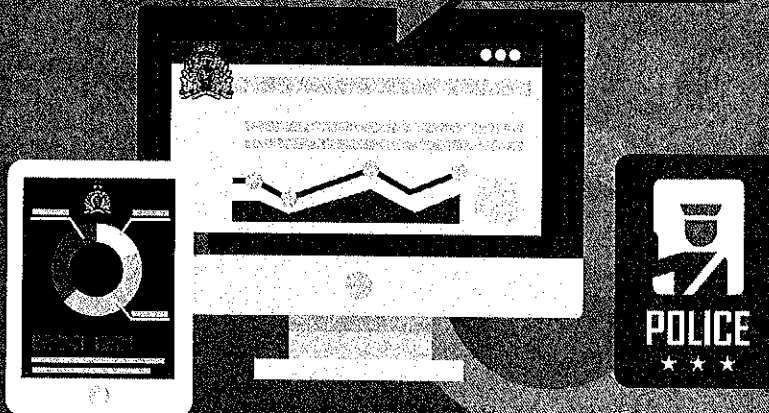

**✓ YOU CAN FILE A REPORT IF:**

- You have lost something that costs less than \$5000
- Someone has stolen something from you that costs less than \$5000
- Someone has vandalized your property or vehicle and it will cost less than \$5000 to repair it
- The crime happened within the jurisdiction of the Alberta RCMP
- Thefts over \$5,000 are accepted from oil, telecommunications, and utility companies

**✗ YOU CANNOT USE ONLINE CRIME REPORTING IF:**

- There is a witness or suspect
- There are lost or stolen items involving personal identity, firearms, licence plates or decals



All crimes reported online to the Alberta RCMP will be followed up with a phone call from a police officer within five business days.

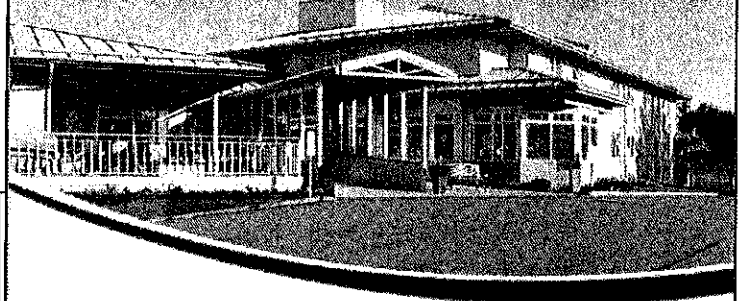

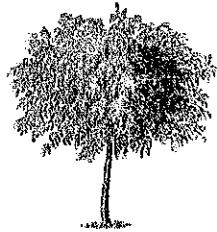



## VILLAGE OF GLENWOOD PROJECTS

The Village Council, through its 2023 Capital Budget, has approved many projects to be undertaken in 2023 as follows:

1. Road rehabilitation will take place throughout the remainder of 2023 including but not limited to pothole repair, application of non-corrosive dust suppressant, gravelling and re-oil of some roads within the Village;
2. Replacement of the old water well with a new well and shack and new plumbing and decommissioning of the old well. This will leave the Village with two dependable wells. This replacement is slated for the fall of 2023;
3. New Windows and door in the Village Office to prevent significant heat loss and allow for the windows to be opened. Old junipers will be removed from the front of the building but the mogo pines will remain;
4. The Community Hall is receiving new insulation, baffles, and soffits at this time. The roof will be insulated to R60 and properly ventilated;
5. The Community Hall will see the carpet replaced with laminated flooring this year; and
6. The bulk water station located at the south side of the Fire Hall will see a significant upgrade this fall.
7. Installation of two electric vehicle stations purchase in 2022 covered by a grant from Climate Change Alberta. These will be placed to the north of the Village Office.
