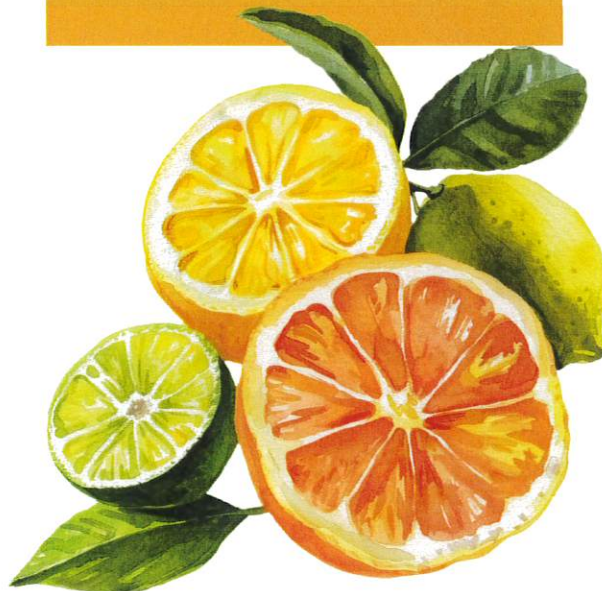


WELCOME TO OUR MONTHLY UPDATE!

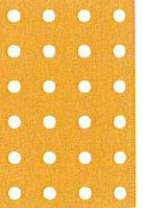
