




## WELCOME TO THE SEPTEMBER EDITION OF THE GLENWOOD GLEANINGS!





October 20, 2025







We're wishing everyone a year filled with growth, learning, and fun! For the most up-to-date school news and important announcements, be sure to visit the **Spring Glen School website**.








