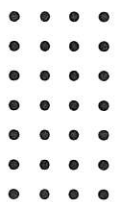




Holiday Closure Notice

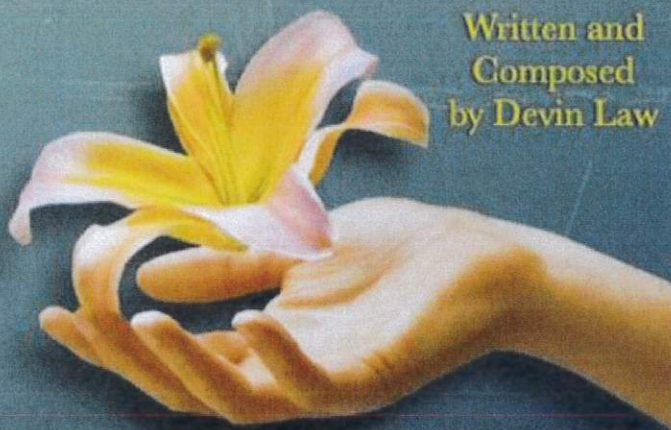
