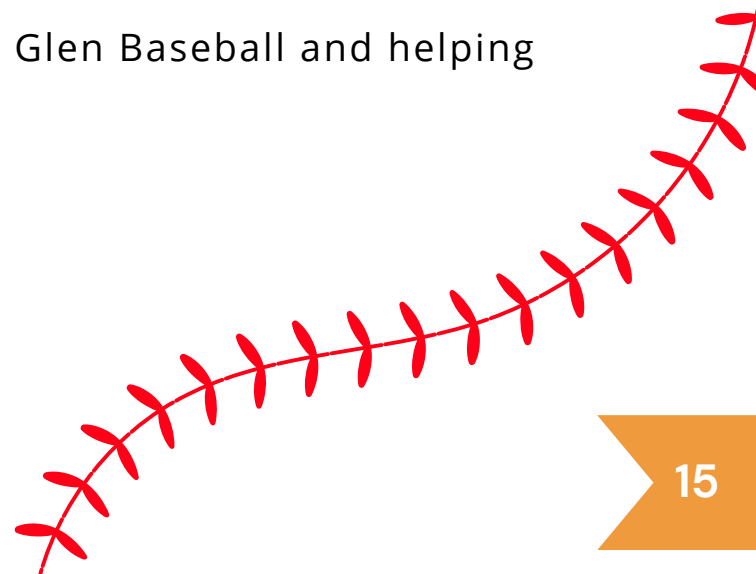
Diamond Cleanup

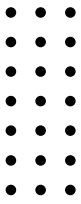
